IQAC discussed the views of the employers with the teaching staff and college management. There was a unanimous view to agree with the views and suggestions. The teachers were advised to inculcate the moral values in the students. IQAC wrote a letter to the University Registrar and the Board of Studies to take action regarding the demands of the Project and Practical works.

There was a common consent on the part of the college authorities to boost the quality of education and the total development of the entire teaching- learning process.
