Y. S Arts & K. S. Shah Commerce College managed by Baria Higher Education Society has become the center of excellence in education for boys and girls students of Devgadh Baria area. The college, commenced in 1964 with only 65 students, is having now total strength of 3099 students. Four languages Gujarati, English, Hindi, and Sanskrit and Economics are offered as principal subjects and three languages, History and Psychology except English are offered as subsidiary subjects as well as five subjects are offered for post- graduation in the college.

The college is awarded with **B** grade (2.24 CGPA) in first cycle by National Assessment and Accreditation council.

Semester wise strength is also noteworthy in college. In the Academic Year 2023-24, **804** students in the first semester [**B. A. SEM. 1 (768), B. COM. SEM 1 (36)**], **755** in third semester and **748** in the fifth semester, total **2307** students are studying and **792** students are studying in post-graduation department. Thus, total strength during this year is **3099**.
