ADJUSTMENT BETWEEN WORKING AND NON-WORKING MOTHERS IN ADOLESCENT CHILDREN OF NORTH GUJARAT

ABSTRACT

The present investigation to find out the difference of adjustment between working and non-working mothers in adolescent children of north gujarat. The sample constructed of 240 adolescence children of working and nonworking mothers. out of which 120 adolescence children of working mother, 60 from nonworking mothers for this purpose of investigation. Adjustment stress scale developed by Smt. Ragini Dubey was administered to measure their adjustment stress level. Scoring has been done as per manual. The data was analyzed by statistical 't' test and correlation. Result was found that, there is significant difference in level of adjustment between working and non-working mothers in adolescent children of north gujarat. It was also found that, there is no significant difference between level of adjustment by cause of gender and standard.

Introduction:

Adjustment is one of the most important psychology activities of human beings . If any one wants satisfaction in life, they have to adjust themselves with their environment. Adjustment is precarious even changing balance between need and desires of the individual on the one hand demands of the environment or society on the other. It is a process through which a person maintains a balance between his needs and situations that effect need satisfaction (Bornin and langfield). According to coleman , adjustment is effectiveness of a person's efforts to adapt his need satisfaction to his environment.

Many problems of available in student's age. International students face a variety of adaptation challenges while studying in the United States and one of the goals of this qualitative study was to identify the kinds of problems that students of a mid-sized university faced. During the last three decads, increasing attention has been given to personality development and adjustment problems of college students.
