Total Strength: 3099

Sample Size: 280 students selected from across the streams of Commerce and Arts (15% of total Strength) Student Selection Criterion: Students are selected on the basis of regularity and performance in Academics.

1. How do you rate the sequence of the courses you have studied in previous semesters?

Response: Excellent.

Action Plan: More vocational courses to be introduced.

2. Is your curriculum relevant to your good future?

Response: Yes, upto 90% felt it was relevant..

Action Plan: More collaborative programmes with industry to be introduced.

3. Are you satisfied with the course content of your programme?

Response: Yes, upto 92%. Most of the courses are compatible with industry and employers' demands.

Action Plan: Effort is to achieve 100% course content satisfaction amongst the students.

4. Are you satisfied with the special programs organised for advance learners and slow learners in your College?

Response: Yes, over 92% feel satisfied.

Action Plan: Tutorials in special classes to be organised to accommodate the students who are slow learners.
