Shah Commerce College, Devgadhi-Baria, ~~and Anandi~~. ANANDI is a voluntary organization registered society under the Societies Registration Act 1860 Guj/5189/ Ahmedabad / 1995. The vision of the organization is to bring rural women's concerns in the Centre of all development processes so that all can live in a just, equitable and peaceful society, ~~to~~ realize the Sustainable Development Goals, ANANDI collaborates with different stakeholders in the community.

This contract is represented by Seema Shah, Practice Lead based at ANANDI, Station Sheri, Devgadhi Baria. Y.S. arts & K.S. Shah Commerce College, Devgadhi-Baria is the first party and Anandi, Station Sheri Devgadhi Baria is the second party.

This is a technical and non-financial partnership with the outcome of gender equality for sustainable development of rural communities in Devgadhi Baria block. This contract is being executed at Devgadhi Baria, Dist: Dahod, Gujarat.

This collaboration will facilitate awareness among youth through collaborative activities with students and their communities and foster the goal of gender equality and gender justice in rural communities. ANANDI as a field level organization in the area will arrange and coordinate events in collaboration with the college and students in the rural areas. The YS Arts and KS Shah Commerce College will ensure participation of the students as part of building social awareness and citizenship among youth. They will be encouraged to work towards practical solutions to individual and community problems for social justice.

### Objectives of the collaboration

Keeping with the goal of advancing rights of youth, ANANDI will organize four events in a year

- Collaborate with NSS and such initiatives of the college to provide holistic understanding regarding protection and wellbeing of youth.

- Sensitize youth for prevention of violence against women, girls and other socially marginalized communities for social justice.
- Build awareness about Women's Human Rights and the Constitutional rights.

#### **I. Activities proposed to be conducted during the year**

ANANDI team will consultatively plan and organize activities with the college staff and student leaders who would be part of the activities. Following are the activities proposed:

1. Every year 25<sup>th</sup> November to 10<sup>th</sup> December is celebrated as a campaign for prevention of Gender Based Violence, globally. There will be an awareness workshop in the college campus to build an understanding on Human Rights. The participants will be familiarized with basic concepts of Gender, Patriarchy, Masculinity and understand how it impacts women, girls and boys.
2. During the Jagya Apni Jumbesh around 14<sup>th</sup> February, ANANDI will organize documentary film festival with discussion with youth in audience
3. Learnings from the 10 years of the National Food Security Act in India during December 2023. This will be done with multiple activities including workshop, field interaction, community mapping and report presentation by students. This process can be done with a group of 30 - 40 students taking up the action in their own village. The ANANDI team will support the students in the community. The Y.S. Arts and K.S. Shah Commerce College may decide to involve volunteers of the National Service Scheme (NSS). A small community study can be used as a community research report by ANANDI and the college.
4. ANANDI organizes theatre workshop for young girls who commit to volunteer for 10-15 days. ANANDI has trained many youths in the past who later used their understanding and art for social change. End of this process the groups put together a small street play on issues of community concern. The selection process for this workshop is led by ANANDI team and registration for participation will be a compulsory requirement.
5. To encourage youth to write and express their views freely, ANANDI will announce Essay Competition with college students. Registration for participation will be a compulsory requirement.

The Memorandum of Understanding is applicable from 1 October 2023 to 30 September 2023


iii. Review and Renewal
